Introduction:

Discussion about service and the three types of service (indirect, direct and advocacy)

Model indirect service through the NaNoWriMo English project -- students get sponsors for the number of words they write for their novels. The money goes to Room to Read

Model advocacy through the HUMAN RIGHTS DAY posters related to the Individuals and Societies topic.

Next - students will begin to embark on a discovery process for what they might be excited or interested in pursuing in relation to service:
